


DRAFT POLICY LETTER ON POSTING/TRANSFER OF GIRL CADETS
INSTRUCTORS (GCI's) WITH IN DIRECTORATE

1. 30% of total GCI's strength in the State would be turned over every year.
2. Normal tenure of a GCI would be three years. However, extension upto five years may be granted in exceptional cases.
3. No extension would be granted at high pressure stations, such as Lucknow, Agra, Kanpur, Allahabad etc.
4. While granting extension of two years, individual performance and recommendations of the CO/Gp Cdr would be the main deciding factor.
5. Effort would be made to accommodate such GCIs whose husbands are also working by posting them in the same stations. However, in any case, tenure will not be increased for more than five years.
6. GCIs having below average performance/disciplinary cases may be posted out even before normal tenure of three years. No extension would be considered in such cases.
7. After issue of posting order, no representation would be entertained as all GCIs are liable to serve any where in the State.
8. For extension of tenure, individual should apply minimum six months before the expiry of normal tenure in the station.
9. Last tenure posting will only be considered if the residual tenure of the applicant left out in between 1½ to 2 years before date of retirement of the individual. No applications should, therefore, be fwd if less than 1½ years are remaining before retirement. Even if received by this office no action will be taken and the unit should not expect a reply.
10. The choice station asked by the individual will be restricted to only one station as last tenure posting has to be at one station for purpose of settlement/home posting. In case the individual desires to be considered for any station nearby in case of non-availability of vacancy in the one choice station, he should indicate 'or near by'.
11. GCIs asking posting on medical ground will forward recommendation of Army specialist doctors. If no M H is available where unit is located they will obtain the views of specialists posted in nearest M H.
